## **BREED LCP 2011 Awards Night Eligibility and Nomination Guidelines**

The Annual 'BREED Community Partnership Awards for Excellence in Industry' is approaching and is scheduled for 16<sup>th</sup> November 2010. There are areas for nominations covering any eligible young person aged 13-19, employer, or organisation. For the 2011 Awards Night, the closing date for all nominations will be 15<sup>th</sup> October 2011, and covers the 12 months leading up to this from 15<sup>th</sup> October 2010. The event is about recognising and celebrating those companies and young people who are exceptional and are a role model for others to aspire to.

As in past years, the 2011 awards focus on young people aged 13-19 in the Blacktown LGA (Local Government Area) & St Marys area or the willing companies or organisations that support them in their careers. The criterion promotes the attitudes that industry need in their human resources to be successful, or for the industry category, those organisations that have made a real difference helping those same young people to acquire skills and prepare for a great career.

### **Exceptional Employer offering quality VET Work Placements or a quality 'Work Experience'** **( up to 13 employers may receive an Award )**

Employers/organisations are eligible where they have taken one or more local teenagers (who live in, or go to school/TAFE/University in, the Blacktown LGA) for Work Experience from School or TAFE or provided a Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) work placement to help students complete their Vocational Education and Training (VET) course.

Nomination form to be completed by a teenager, School/TAFE/Uni staff, or member of the community who feels an employer has provided a valuable SWL work placement or Work Experience for a local teenager.

### **Exceptional Young Person - Nominated by industry** **( Awards for up to 19 local youth )**

Exceptional local teenagers (those who live in, are employed in, or go to school/TAFE/University in the Blacktown LGA) are eligible where a Supervisor or Manager feels that the qualities that teenager displayed are those that their industry wants to promote to succeed in the workforce. They should be under 20yrs of age and nominated by industry.

There is a category for Work Experience from TAFE or School, for those in a Traineeship, those in an Apprenticeship, and one category for each of the Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses provided in the Blacktown LGA.

### **Outstanding Local Youth Programmes** **( 1 Award )**

Nomination form can be completed by anyone in the community and is to recognise those programmes helping young people aged 13-19 from the area BREED LCP supports (Blacktown, Mt Druitt, & St Marys areas) to assist young people increase the attitude and skills that industry admire so that those young people are more employable.
